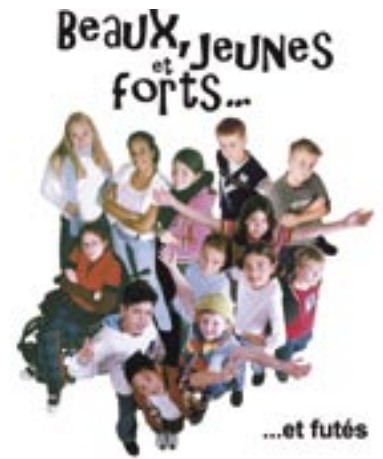

# ANSWERS

### Question 1

---

*Laws and rules like the school code of conduct are there to protect us and help people live together.*

**True.** The code of conduct includes all the school rules. These rules explain how the students and staff of the school should treat one another. This helps prevent fights and promotes harmony in the school.

### Question 2

---

*One of the roles of a police officer is to protect people from criminals.*

**True.** The police are officers of the peace whose duties include protecting people and arresting criminals. Their work also includes enforcing the laws and giving out tickets.

### Question 3

---

*"Taxing" is a crime officially called robbery.*

**True.** Taxing is when someone steals something from someone else by scaring them into handing it over. The person who does the taxing forces the victim to give them their lunch, their money, etc. Taxers usually pick on people who are smaller than them.

### Question 4

---

*Sometimes students fight with each other. If I see this happening, I should try to separate them before they get hurt.*

**False.** The best idea is to tell an adult and let them stop the fight before the students get hurt. Don't try to separate them yourself, because you could get hurt. The best way to stop a fight is to calm down, talk to each other, and try to find a solution that satisfies both sides.

### Question 5

---

*I only have to wear a seatbelt if the car is driving very fast or if a grownup tells me to.*

**False.** You always have to wear a seatbelt, even if you aren't going very far and even if the car is driving slowly. Even at a low speed, you won't be able to restrain yourself in an accident and you could get seriously hurt.

### Question 6

---

*I'm shopping with my parents and suddenly I can't see them anymore. I should walk around and look for them.*

**False.** It's better to stay in the same place so your parents can find you or go to the closest salesperson and ask for help.

### Question 7

---

*Someone at school hits me or insults me. I should tell them to leave me alone, ignore them or just turn around and walk away.*

**True.** Even if it's hard to hide your fear, you should tell the person to leave you alone. It is important to let the person know you won't just put up with this behaviour. Talk to your teacher or to another adult you trust.

### Question 8

---

*In the park near where I live, I find a syringe on the ground. I should throw it in the garbage can, being very careful not to prick myself.*

**False.** You should never ever touch a syringe! You might prick yourself and get very sick. Instead you should tell an adult and get them to pick it up and throw it away safely. Don't let your friends touch the syringe either!
